What information do we collect?

When you make a workshop booking through our website we need to know your name, e-mail address and emergency phone number. This allows us to add you as a confirmed booking to the workshop and we can contact you if we need to in relation to the workshop. We also ask you for your telephone number(s) so that we can contact you easily if required.

If you order goods through our website, we collect your Name, address and payment details, Contact information including email address, Demographic information such as postcode.

Photos/videos

How do we use your information?

We require this information to:

Where you have signed up to our email subscription service we may periodically send promotional emails about new products and exclusive offers or other information which we think you may find interesting using the email address which you have provided

We do not sell, trade or rent your personal information to others.
